Attendees select the topics which most closely align with their job responsibilities or areas of interest and are not limited in any way with regards to which sessions they may wish to attend. Each track consists of several presentations lasting approximately 60 minutes each and ranging from introductory 100-level content to highly technical, 400-level "expert" sessions. The speakers represent a broad cross section of the development community and offer a variety of different perspectives regarding application architecture, design and development. Some of those sessions are demos, so that attendees can learn with hands-on experience. We also encourage the sponsors to submit technical talks and demos. No overt sales pitches or commercial talks will be allowed, and the sponsorship does not guarantee the speaker's selections.

PLATINUM: \$3000 (Grandfather \$2000)

As a PLATINUM sponsor, you'll have your logo featured on the website, session materials, and keynote slide, including the presentations of three highlighted speakers. A booth for your company display, and a lunchtime presentation slot will be provided.

Post-event, you'll receive an opt-in attendees list, and your logo will be visible on all additional signage and presenter slides. Raffle item donations valued at \$300 will be recognized during the day.

Please note, sponsorship prices have increased due to inflation. However, sponsors from the last two years will receive the previous price, under our new grandfather clause.

GOLD: \$2000 (Grandfather \$1000)

As a GOLD sponsor, you'll have your logo featured on the website, session materials, and the Gold keynote slide, including a mention in our 3 featured speaker sessions. A company booth with provided tables and chairs is included for your use.



Your collateral will be placed in the attendee bags on the event day. Should you donate a raffle item valued at a minimum of \$300, it will be highlighted at some point during the day, with recognition given to your company.

Please note, due to inflation, the sponsorship price has increased. However, if you've sponsored in the past two years, you're eligible for the previous price, as per our grandfather clause.

SILVER: \$1000 (Grandfather \$500)

As a SILVER sponsor, your logo will be prominently displayed on the website and session materials. Additionally, you can provide collateral for inclusion in the attendee bags distributed at event registration.

If you choose to donate a raffle item worth a minimum of \$300, it will be featured during the day with your company receiving due recognition.

As the SPEAKER SHIRT sponsor you are responsible for providing 50 Polo Shirts for the speakers (various sizes). The Atlanta Developers' Conference logo will be embedded on one side of the shirt and your company logo will be on the other side of the shirt. Speaker shirts must be available the week before the event.
